Sub: **Uploading the details of students to be admitted in BDS Course at Dental Colleges for the academic session 2019-2020, on DCI Website.**

Sir / Madam,

The undersigned directed to clarify for the information of general public as well as all the dental colleges and their Affiliating Universities, counseling authorities designated by the respective State Governments, Deemed Universities, Director Medical Education or any other stakeholder involved in counseling of the students for admission, that the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its Order dated 16.09.2019 in M.A. No.1933-34 of 2019 in Writ Petition (C) No.76 of 2015 – Ashish Ranjan & Ors. Vs. Union of India & Ors. a moved by State of Jammu & Kashmir has been pleased to extend the time to conduct the common online counseling and admission to BDS Course upto 30.11.2019.

The Executive Committee of the DCI in its meeting held on 26.09.2019 considered the Order alongwith the said M.A. application No.1933-34 of 2019 moved by State of Jammu & Kashmir, inter-alia, praying “*extend the time line for counseling and admission to the BDS Course in the State of J & K for filling up the additional seats of 10% quota to Economically Weaker Sections for academic year 2019-20 by four weeks beyond 31st October, 2019*” and telephonic confirmation by Sh. Gaurav Sharma, Advocate about the time extended upto 30.11.2019 applicable only to State of Jammu & Kashmir not for any other State. The Executive Committee accordingly decided to clarify this position to all the stakeholders and also to make it clear that no counseling authority except that of the authority of State of Jammu & Kashmir, shall conduct counseling for BDS admissions pursuant to the said Order in violation of the Time Schedule prescribed by DCI.

Accordingly, I am directed to bring the aforesaid clarification as per decision taken by the Executive Committee of the DCI to the notice of all the stakeholders and general public. It is once again made it clear that the time to conduct the common online counseling and admission to BDS Course extended to 30.11.2019 by the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its Order dated 16.09.2019 in M.A. No.1933-34 of 2019 in Writ Petition (C) No.76 of 2015 – Ashish Ranjan & Ors. Vs. Union of India & Ors shall be applicable only to State of Jammu & Kashmir.
