

Dental Council of India

Sub: Permission for Temporary Registration

It is submitted that as per guidelines approved by the General Body of the DCI, following documents are required to send the Dental Council of India from the organizer for getting the temporary registration u/s 34(2) (b) of the Dentists Act, 1948, in India, as under:-

1. Name of Dental Institution viz. approved/recognized dental college OR Organisation/Association/Trust/Hospital/University alongwith certificate copy of its valid Registration Number, desire to conduct the dental teaching/research programme.
2. Exact date/s and venue/s for organizing the programme.
3. Purpose for conducting/inviting the foreign dentists.
4. Complete Bio-data of the invitee foreign dentist/s including the details of his/her qualification, clinical experience etc.
5. Documentary proof of current registration of invitee foreign dentist/s alongwith the validity of his/her registration in his/her respective State Dental Council.
6. An undertaking from the concerned invitee foreign dentist/s that he/she will not conduct the said programme for personal gain or profit purpose.
7. All the documents/certificates shall be in English Version and self attested. In case, the certificates are in different language, furnish the certified copies of English version.
8. Demand Draft of Rs. 3000/- for each invitee foreign dentists, fee for Temporary Registration (NOC) in favour of Secretary, Dental Council of India, New Delhi..
